

# NERI



Kempegowda International Airport, named after Kempe Gowda I, the founder of Bangalore, is an international airport serving Bangalore. Spread over 4,000 acres it is the third busiest airport behind the airports in Delhi and Mumbai. The airport has two passenger terminals that handle both domestic and international operations. Neri supplied decorative poles and light fixtures to both terminals. Light 851 with Maia design pole was selected for terminal – 1.
















Futuristic Terminal 2 with its exceptional design and architectural brilliance was unveiled in 2023. Terminal 2 clinched UNESCO's coveted recognition as one of the 'World's Most Beautiful Airports'. Neri Light 110 was selected for the outdoor areas of terminal 2 & was also used in Terminal 1.

















The Statue of Prosperity is the statue of the founder and architect of the city of Bangalore, Kempe Gowda (1510 - 1569). It is constructed in a theme park of 23 acres around the Airport. The 108-foot-high statue is a main attraction in the newly launched Terminal 2 (T2) of the Kempegowda International Airport. Neri Light Hydra was selected for the theme park.
